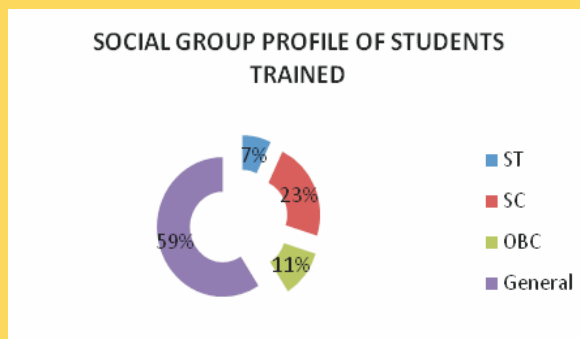
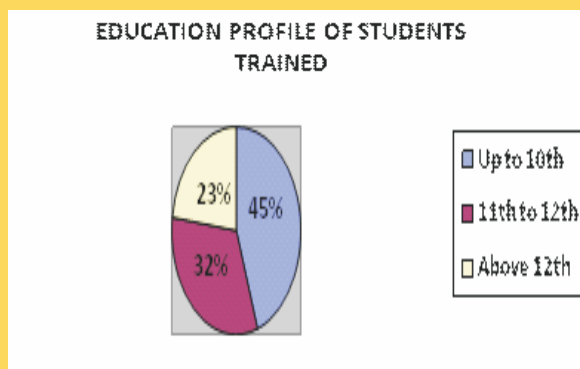
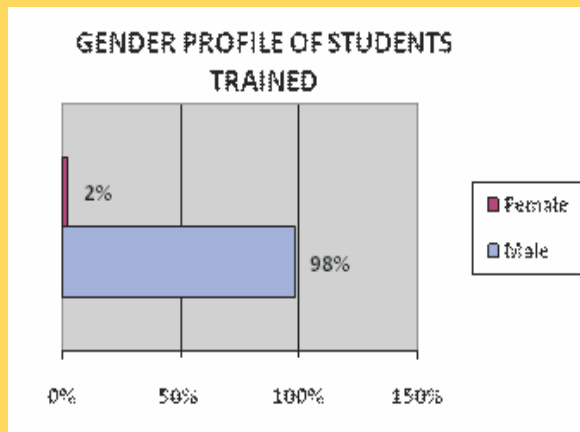
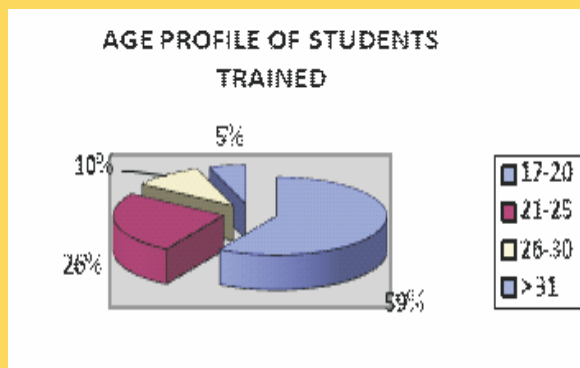


PROVIDING EMPLOYABILITY SKILLS TO LOCAL RURAL YOUTH - MAHINDRA WORLD CITY, JAIPUR
