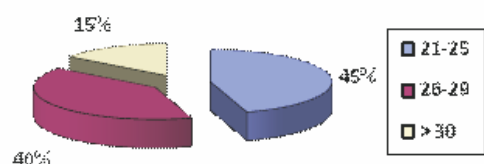
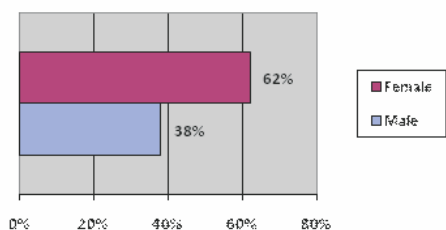

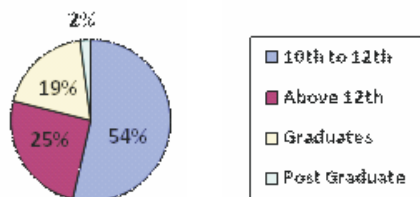
AGE PROFILE OF STUDENTS TRAINED



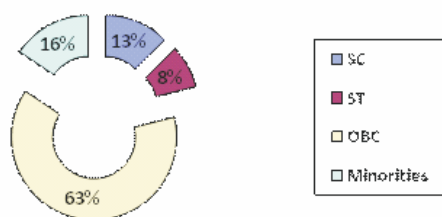
GENDER PROFILE OF STUDENTS TRAINED



EDUCATION PROFILE OF STUDENTS TRAINED



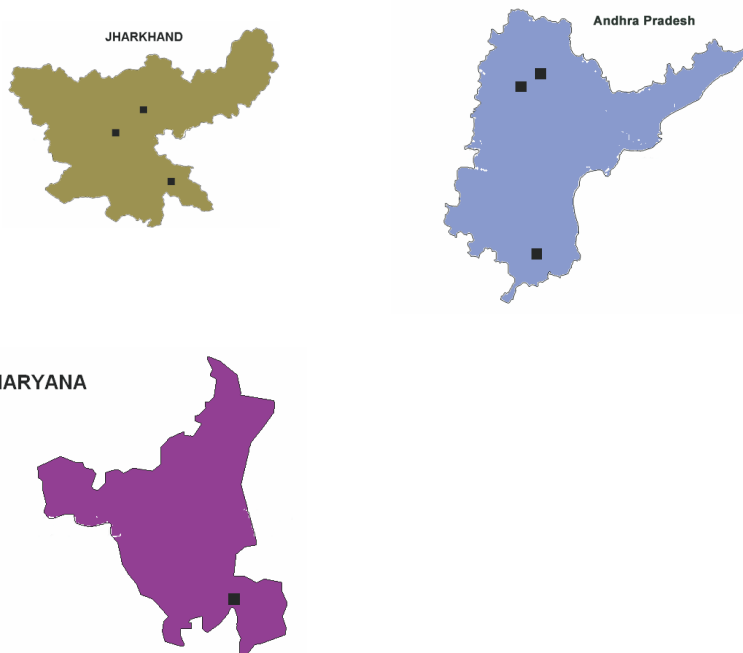
SOCIAL GROUP PROFILE OF STUDENTS TRAINED
