














## Impact – placements

On completion of two months of classroom training and one month of on the job training, the candidates are provided with placement opportunities.



### **Case Studies**



Nisha Devi, from Brhamni village of Hamirpur District comes from a family of 5 with very difficult financial background. Rohit Kumar is a very enthusiastic and innovative candidate who belongs in BPL family of Anukalan area in Hamirpur.

Rohit lost his father in his early childhood. Rohit's elder brother is the sole breadwinner for the family of 5 members. Despite working double shifts for days together they were unable to meet the basic needs of the family. Rohit seeing the plight and helplessness of his brother was determined to

support his family however was clueless on the direction to achieve his goals.

Rohit always dreamed of starting something on his own but financial condition of his family would not support the same. Rohit heard about the program through one of the mobilization camps that has been conducted in his area and decided at once to join the program.
